But His work through Chosen People Ministries goes beyond Israel as well!

A multitude of Jewish people are also coming to faith in Jesus in Germany, the United States, Russia and in many other places in the world. This is exciting, but we must make sure that we have the staff to help disciple these new Jewish believers.

This is why I am initiating The Daniel Fuchs Memorial Fund at this historic time in the life of our mission. Dr. Fuchs was the beloved President of Chosen People Ministries through the turbulent, but blessed 1960s and 70s. The Mission grew at an unprecedented rate during that season of revival among Jewish

young people. Many of our present leaders received the Lord during this time.

In fact, Dr. Fuchs is the man God used to help me receive a scholarship to attend Bible college. His encouragement helped prepare me to serve the Lord in this ministry. Many of us within the Chosen People Ministries family want to honor his great legacy by establishing this much-needed matching grant fund.

The Daniel Fuchs Memorial Fund will help provide matching funds for Jewish evangelism in difficult places like Israel, Russia and the Ukraine, and will be used for the training of new leaders in the field of Jewish missions. It is my prayer that many, like Neriyah and myself, will come to faith, grow in grace and serve as missionaries with Chosen People Ministries.

Most of these *future* missionaries cannot raise the funds to go to Bible school or to serve as full-time missionaries. We want to help them by establishing a matching gift fund so that funds raised locally <u>may be multiplied.</u>

We want to do all we can to help raise the funds they need.

The Russian Jews especially need our help, as it is almost impossible to raise local funding in Russia and Israel and often even in North America for the work among the Jewish people.
