live in exciting
times. How can
you possibly

watch the news and not see prophecy after prophecy fulfilled before your very eyes? The *modern* state of Israel is now 59 years old, but the ancient promises of peace in the Land are still far from fulfilled! There is unrest within the chosen nation, and she is surrounded by determined enemies seeking her destruction. At this time, the United States is still Israel's best friend, but unfortunately, many Christian leaders lack vision for Israel's future. Even a former president has published a book calling for the U.S. to rethink her policies of friendship with Israel.

I am sorry to say that these views have spilled over into many areas—including the need to share the Gospel with the Jewish people. An anti-Israel position has a way of *morphing* into an anti-Jewish position.

When the Church is not positive towards the Jewish people, interest in and commitment to reaching Jewish people for Jesus weakens and wanes.

This newsletter is designed to challenge believers and local churches to renew their love for the Jewish people and to deepen their commitment to Jewish evangelism.

Dear friend, your Mission to the Jewish people cannot reach Jewish people for the Messiah without you! We want to do all we can to encourage, empower and equip Christians and local churches to reach Jewish people for Jesus.

We are grateful for all that God is doing through you and other believers who are still committed to the Jewish people, the nation of Israel and Jewish evangelism!

Chosen People Ministries: Helping Your Church to Reach the Jewish People

For more than a century, Chosen People Ministries has proclaimed the Gospel to the Jewish people. Your

Mission's partnership with churches and church members is the practical outworking of the wonderful mystery explained by the Apostle Paul in the "olive tree" illustration found in Romans 11:16-24—that Jews and Gentiles are brothers and sisters in Messiah.

In verse 11, Paul makes it clear that Gentile believers are called to reach Jewish people through their lives, love and witness: *"I say then, have they stumbled that they should fall? Certainly not! But through their fall, to provoke them to jealousy, salvation has come to the Gentiles"* (Romans 11:11). We are also partners in ministry, and for many years I have been keenly aware of the value of partnering with individual Christians and churches in sharing the Good News with Jewish people. Partnering with churches in Jewish evangelism is not an option. It is a necessity!

We think so highly of the importance of involving local churches in Jewish evangelism and support of the Jewish people that we

actually have a Department of Church Ministries, guided by Dr. Rich Freeman, who has written an article in this newsletter. I hope you will be encouraged by these articles and prayerfully find ways to become involved—personally or through your church—in Jewish evangelism.

Jewish Evangelism and the Jewish People

Chosen People Ministries is committed to reaching our beloved Jewish people and helping churches and church members to do likewise.

For example, Cathy Wilson, one of our most creative and energetic staff members, has partnered with her home church in Scottsdale, Arizona, where she has formed a Jewish ministry team. The team's goal is to educate the church about the Jewish roots of Christianity and train its members to reach the large Jewish community in Scottsdale. This is a wonderful illustration of the kind of partnership that extends the reach of the Gospel among the Jewish people. What a joy it would be if local churches across our country even began praying regularly for the salvation of Jewish people.



Another way to come alongside Jewish people concerns the State of Israel. As I mentioned above, we are seeing an anti-Israel shift in attitude, even here in the United States.

As a result, Jewish people are becoming increasingly aware of who their friends are. One very important thing that you and your church can do to reach out to Jewish people is to become aware of and lend your

prayers and support to local events in defense of Israel being sponsored by the Jewish community. Writing letters to the editor of your local newspaper is a wonderful way to show your love for Israel and the Jewish people.

Growing Opportunities for Jewish Evangelism

In the past few years, many synagogues have been actually reaching out to local churches in order to build friendships—especially because of those Christians who have become known within the Jewish community as friends and not foes.

This growing Christian friendship with the Jewish people has softened some of the Jewish antagonism towards Christianity. This is why I want to encourage this support to continue. Many Jewish people around the world are *spiritually curious*. A more open door for the Gospel will result in a fuller harvest for the Kingdom. Jewish people, especially in light of the disturbing history between Judaism and Christianity, need to be explicitly shown Christian love.

Training Resources for Your Church

The Jewish people are still one of the most unreached people groups in the world, with less than 1% being believers in Messiah. Bringing Jewish people to faith is a challenging and faith-building experience. Chosen People Ministries has excellent training resources for church members who have a burden to reach "the Jew first" (Romans 1:16).

Our foremost training resource is our missionary staff! Our Church Ministries department would be delighted to schedule a speaker to lead a seminar on Jewish evangelism

during your Sunday services or your missions conference.

Our online resource catalogue (www.chosenpeople.com/store) has books, tracts, articles and videos that will help you understand how to share the Gospel in a culturally sensitive way with your Jewish friend, neighbor or relative.

Building bridges is an essential part of the picture. Are there



Messianic leaders in your area? Perhaps you can approach them for ideas. Another way to begin is to partner with ministries that are already involved in Jewish evangelism. Local churches need the help

and partnership of Jewish believers and Messianic congregations to reach Jewish people, just as we need the support of the local church. You may call our offices to find out if a Chosen People Ministries worker or other Messianic ministry representative is in your area.

It takes only one person in a church to light a fire for Jewish outreach. **You can be that person!** Your prayers, vision and willingness to find kindred spirits in your church fellowship may be the foundation upon which a meaningful ministry of Jewish evangelism could be built. Our Ministry to the Church & to the Jewish People

As my brother and friend Mitch Glaser rightly observes in the previous article, Chosen People Ministries and the local church work hand in hand. Each has its role to play in winning Jewish people to Messiah, and each can do things the other cannot.

In my many years of ministry, I have grown keenly aware of how much those of us in Jewish missions have been blessed by churches. It is my heart's desire for Chosen People Ministries to serve God's people in the churches and in doing so, to serve the Messiah to whom we are all so indebted.

What is our blessed hope? It is the return of the Messiah. Although we do not know the day and the hour, we are convinced that it will happen. Until that day, we have been charged in the Great Commission (Matthew 28:18-20) with the task of bringing the Gospel "to the Jew first and to the Gentile" (Romans 1:16).

DAVID'S DYNASTY AND GOD'S FAITHFULNESS

We have explored King David's role as both a poet and a warrior, but he was also a visionary. He planned for Jerusalem to be the political and spiritual center of his kingdom. Once the Ark of the Covenant was relocated to Jerusalem from the city of Kirjath Jearim, then Jerusalem would indeed become the Holy City and spiritual center of Israel.

DAVID'S DESIRE TO CONSTRUCT A TEMPLE TO HOUSE THE ARK

After the Ark arrived, King David was concerned that it should rest in a temple worthy of it. David lived in a beautiful cedar palace that the Phoenicians had built for him, and he was embarrassed that the dwelling place of the Ark was so unimpressive.

But God denied David's request to build a temple for the Ark. According to the message the Lord conveyed through Nathan the prophet (2 Samuel 7:3-16), David's many years as a warrior involved him in much bloodshed and made his request for such an important work inappropriate.

David's conversation with Nathan must have been very difficult. But although David would not be permitted to build a temple for the Ark, the Lord promised him that a greater house would be built and established forever (2 Samuel 7:16).

GOD'S COVENANT WITH DAVID

The Lord revealed many important prophecies in the Davidic Covenant. These include:

- ✧ David's son Solomon will establish the kingdom of Israel and build

the Temple
(2 Samuel 7:12-13).

- ✧ The throne of Solomon's kingdom will endure forever (2 Samuel 7:13) after some temporary interruptions (2 Kings 25).

- ✧ The Davidic kingdom will be established eternally (2 Samuel 7:16; 1 Corinthians 15:24).

- ✧ The Davidic line would always be the royal line and would include an actual earthly kingdom.

The Davidic Covenant also contains many promises, some of which have come to pass and others of which have yet to be fulfilled. It ensures that the nation of Israel will be preserved by God and returned to her land, and that David's greater Son—Messiah Jesus—will return to rule over all Israel in Jerusalem.

THE PLEDGE OF GOD'S FAITHFULNESS

Psalm 89 may have been written during the darkest days of the Babylonian captivity. But even in such trying times, the Psalmist sings of the faithfulness and mercy of God that is best illustrated by the Davidic Covenant: "I have made a covenant with My chosen, I have sworn to My servant David: 'Your seed I will establish forever, and build up your throne to all generations'" (Psalm 89:3, 4).

This promise is expressed another way in the words of the angel Gabriel to Mary in the Gospel of Luke: "He [Jesus] will be great, and will be called the Son of the Highest; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David. And He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there will be no end" (Luke 1:32, 33). ✧



FAITH DECISION AT MESSIAH IN THE PASSOVER PRESENTATION
